

Q&A No. 1 – Granite Knolls Parking Lot Paving Bid

1. There is no spec for the Joint Adhesive 418.7603 as per detail R-1 and not included in spec sections 0401 & 0402. Please provide a spec for this. **Refer to the NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS (USC), Volume 2, Dated May 1 2026 for adhesive NYSDOT Item No. 418.7603 shown on the Typical Asphalt Parking Lot Section.**
2. Detail R-3 indicates Epoxy Resin for pavement markings. There is no spec for Epoxy Resin. Spec section 0501 is for paint. Usually you need to wait 14 days to apply epoxy after the top course is complete. What materials do you want to use? **Paint**
3. Is the Geotechnical Testing agency supplied by the owner for checking subgrade and compaction testing? 0201-3 **No, the testing firm is hired by the contractor.**
4. Please identify the permits and costs the contractor needs to supply. **No permits necessary**
5. There are approx. 100+/- parking bumpers in the existing parking lot. Who is responsible to remove and store these? **As noted in the bid, contractor must remove bumpers and place on supplied pallet. The town will remove the pallet. The bumpers will not need to be reinstalled.**
6. Spec 10.1 allows the Town 60 days to award the job. The job needs to be awarded several weeks prior to August 1<sup>st</sup> start to procure materials and to get granular stockpiles built and tested. **The job will be awarded as soon as possible.**
7. Is there new underdrain running west to east at the south end of the parking lot? **No, there is no underdrain required along the south end of the parking lot.**
8. Does the Mirafi 500X run from curb to curb also or just under the Porous Asphalt areas? **Mirafi 500X runs curb to curb as shown on Detail.**
9. Please confirm work hours and deliveries are Monday to Saturday 8:00a to 6:00pm. **From August 1<sup>st</sup> – August 16<sup>th</sup> the awarded contractor will welcome to receive orders at any time, since the park will be closed to the public during construction. However the Town would prefer the reasonable hours you suggested.**
