

DID YOU KNOW?

In 2023, a family of four with children in childcare in Westchester needed \$131,316 just to cover the essentials – more than four times the Federal Poverty Level of \$30,000. Yet even with both parents working full time in two of the state's most common jobs – a personal care aide and a stock worker/order filler – this family's combined income still fell short of the cost of basics by \$57,436.

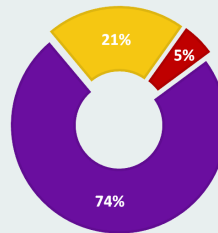
ALICE® is an acronym for **that stands for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed** – households that earn more than the Federal Poverty Level, but less than the basic cost of living for the county (the ALICE Threshold).

ALICE is a registered trademark of the United Way of Northern New Jersey.

4 out of every 10 households in Putnam and Westchester are living pay-check to pay-check or in poverty.

No savings for emergencies and no investment in the future for education, home ownership or retirement.
