

PART THREE

A. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. Term: This Contract is a one-year contract.
2. Option to Extend:
 - a. Town shall have the unilateral option of extending this contract for three (3) additional years on the same terms and conditions as are contained in this contract at the time said options is exercised.
 - b. Said option shall be exercised by written notification from Town not less than thirty (30) calendar prior to the expiration of the contract.
 - c. Bidders are cautioned that the exercise of the option is a Town prerogative, not a contractual right on the part of Bidder. If the Town exercises the option within the time frame prescribed herein, Bidder shall be contractually bound to perform the services for the option period.
3. Nature of Bid: This bid seeks bidders for one or more contracts to supply the Town with asphalt concrete laid in place. The Town reserves the right to award contracts to each of the lowest bidder for each item with respect to which bids are requested on the bid proposal form.
4. Price shall include the cost of:
 - a. hot mix material,
 - b. delivery to site over properly conditioned roads,
 - c. application of hot mix with approved spreader machine capable of paving a continuous 16' wide traffic lane,
 - d. compaction of material using two approved steel drum rollers one of which must be vibratory (minimum compaction effort 16 tons combined), and
 - e. all supplemental labor, tools, and equipment required to complete such laid in place work.
5. All traffic control and scheduling will be the responsibility of the Superintendent of Highways.
6. Total quantities of laid in place asphalt to be purchased by the Town are indeterminate. For the purpose of this bid the contractor shall assume a minimum daily production rate of 500 tons per day.
7. All asphalt concrete items shall be subject to price adjustment as provided by New York State Office of General Services. Bidders shall use the April 1st, 2026 posting as the base price for this bid.
8. In requesting payment, the vendor shall invoice the Town for the number of tons at the bid price. An additional statement on the same invoice form will designate the price
