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Dear Members of the Town Board / Zoning Board,

I am writing to formally express my strong opposition to the proposed installation of a cell phone tower at 62 Granite Springs Road, Yorktown Heights, NY 10598.

This proposed site is located within a residential area and in close proximity to Sparkle Lake, a valued natural resource enjoyed by residents for recreation, wildlife observation, and its scenic beauty. The construction and presence of a cell tower in this location would negatively affect the surrounding natural environment, including mature trees, local wildlife, and the overall ecological balance of the area.

The removal or disturbance of trees to accommodate the tower and its access infrastructure would permanently alter the landscape and diminish the natural character of the neighborhood. Trees play a critical role in protecting air quality, reducing noise, supporting wildlife, and maintaining the health of the lake and surrounding ecosystem. Any damage to this environment is a serious concern for residents who value conservation and environmental protection.

In addition, the visual impact of a large tower structure near Sparkle Lake and nearby homes would significantly detract from the scenic and residential character of the area. There are also ongoing concerns about noise from equipment, maintenance activity, and the potential effect on property values.

While there may be differing views regarding **long-term health effects of radiofrequency emissions**, many residents remain deeply concerned about continuous exposure, particularly given the tower's proximity to homes, families, children, and seniors. These concerns contribute to stress and anxiety within the community.

I respectfully urge the Town to reconsider this proposal, conduct a thorough environmental review, explore alternative locations, and engage meaningfully with residents who will be directly affected. Protecting our natural surroundings, neighborhood character, and quality of life should remain a top priority.

Thank you for your time and consideration. I appreciate your service and respectfully request that you oppose the installation of a cell phone tower at this location.
