- \* Weekly Commingled Recycling: Only containers made of plastic, waxed cardboard, glass or metal that held food, beverages or soapy cleaners can be mixed and placed in a recycling bin (cardboard/paper must be in separate bin or paper bag). Never use plastic bags!
- \*Weekly Cardboard/Paper Recycling: Must be placed in separate bin or paper bags. Cardboard boxes must be emptied, flattened and tied in manageable bundles. Never use plastic bags!
- \*\* Westchester County Household Material Recovery Facility(H-MRF): Call for (914) 813-5425 to make an appointment to drop off all hazardous or flammable household products, car tires & paper for shredding at the County facility in Valhalla. No fee for Yorktown residents.
- \*\*\* E\*Waste, Car Tire & Textile Recovery Drop-Off Days: Eligible E\*Waste, car tires, and bags of textiles may be dropped off at the Refuse and Recycling Office on pre-determined days. Please see our website: www.yorktownny.org/refuserecycling OR the annual brochure for drop off dates. \$5 fee for each car tire.
