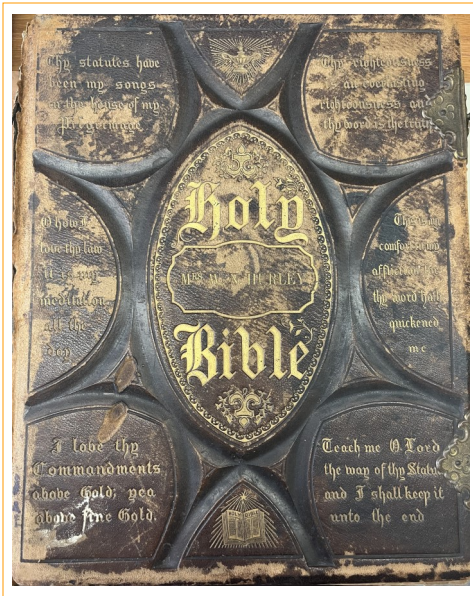

We had a community wide all ages Lego contest!

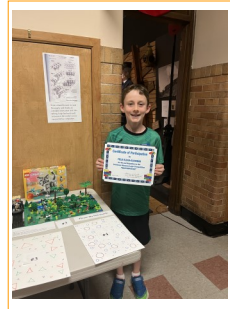
